KING WINS NOMINATION FOR HILL COUNTRY SEAT IN CONGRESS

Will Campaign to Oust Chip Roy in Texas 21st District Contest

[New Braunfels, Texas, March 25, 2024] — Bob King (L-New Braunfels) won the Libertarian Party's nomination for the US House of Representatives in the Texas 21st congressional district at the party's district convention held in New Braunfels on Saturday, and will appear on the ballot in November against Republican incumbent Chip Roy and Democrat challenger Kristin Hook.

"Texans have had enough of the two major parties, the acrimony and their endless, childish posturing," said King. "They inflame readily solvable problems like immigration policy and abortion for electoral advantage, while completely ignoring the real problem of our mounting deficits, driven by the massive growth of the federal government. The voters want a solutions-oriented third option, one who does not care who gets the credit, and only cares about getting things done. And now they will have that option in November."

"The deficits are killing the American dream for younger Americans," King continued. "Annual federal spending is running far ahead of revenues, and politicians are adding more than \$1 trillion a year to the mushrooming \$34.5 trillion debt load. It has given us serious inflation in everything from Happy Meals to housing.

"Neither major party has the moral courage to address this," King added. "Libertarians understand that without major philosophical changes in Washington, our financial future is bleaker than anyone in charge will admit. We need to do things fundamentally differently if we want results to change."

The campaign will host monthly breakfasts, happy hours and other meetings in venues across Texas-21 to meet voters, listen to their concerns, and advocate for solutions rather than endless acrimony.
